Since 2020, the share of EU movers with low education rose to 30% (+3 pps since 2020), while the highly educated remained at 32%



EU movers are 2.4% (209 000) of total healthcare professionals in the EU and EFTA This includes 48 172 doctors and 18 288 nurses



The 'typical' mobile healthcare professional is a women (>90%), between 40 and 49 years old, in full-time employment on a permanent contract
